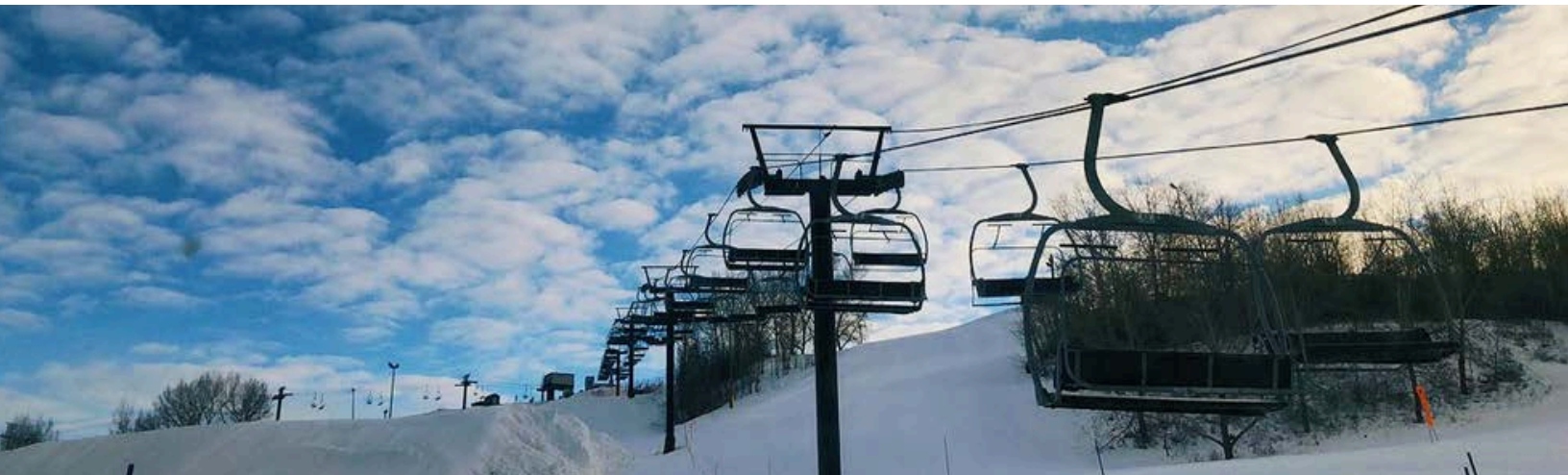

WHAT'S INCLUDED IN OUR SCHOOL GROUP PACKAGE?

Our field trip program offers everything your students need for a great day on the slopes:

- Professional ski and snowboard instructors
- Varied terrain with 11 runs to choose from:
 - The biggest Bunny Hill in the area, serviced by 3 easy-to-use Carpet Lifts
 - Numerous beginner, intermediate, and expert runs serviced by Triple and Quad chairlifts
- High-quality rental equipment for all ages
- Scenic cedar-paneled chalet where supervisors can relax and oversee the group
- One FREE volunteer lift ticket and equipment rental for every 10 students (volunteers must assist in the rental shop before receiving their ticket and rentals)
- 100% snowmaking and daily grooming with modern snow groomers

WHAT TO EXPECT WHEN YOU ARRIVE

A Sunridge field trip is a full day of skiing and snowboarding! Fun, active, and safe. To keep the day running smoothly we've listed some of our procedures to expect on the day of your field trip.

Arrival & Check-In

- After your bus arrives, come to the front entrance where Sunridge staff will hand out lift tickets and zip-ties to all students.
- Students will be directed to a designated area in the chalet for storing backpacks and personal items.

Safety Talk & Grouping

- Students will receive a brief safety talk before the day begins.
- They will then be called up to the rental shop and organized in groups based on their ability level.

Rental Shop & Equipment

- Groups will move to the rental shop together, even if students bring their own gear (so tickets can be marked).
- For beginners, we will write the instructor's name on their ticket.
- For more advanced students, we will write their lesson time and note which runs they are permitted to use.

Lessons

- **Beginners** start lessons as soon as they have equipment.
- **More advanced students** may free ski on designated runs until their lesson time.

WHAT KIND OF SKIER OR SNOWBOARDER ARE YOU?

Before your visit, each student must be assigned a skill level:

Level	Description
Discover	You have never ever skied or snowboarded before.
Green	You have skied or snowboarded less than 5 times OR you prefer to remain on the Bunny Hills.
Blue	You have skied or snowboarded more than 5 times AND you are comfortable/remain in control on both the Bunny Hill and on the green runs off of the chairlifts.
Black	You have skied or snowboarded more than 10 times AND you are an intermediate or advanced skier/boarder. You are fairly confident on all lifts and runs.

After the Lesson

- Students return to the deck with their instructors.
- Our instructors will mark their lift tickets with the approved runs they can now ski or snowboard on. The students are encouraged to stay on the hill and practice their new skills on their designated runs.
- The students can venture to new runs as long as their parent is riding with them and is keeping them safe and in control on the hill.
- **Our ski patrol team may move students to a lower ability level if they are not skiing or snowboarding in control or in a safe manner.**

FINAL REMINDERS

- Field trip rates are only valid for students. Parents or younger siblings cannot join the lessons or receive field trip rates.
- Dress appropriately for winter weather
- Attach lesson ticket immediately when the students get to their designated table in the chalet.
- Seating in the chalet is shared with other school groups and the public.
 - We recommend students keep personal belongings stored neatly to respect the shared space.
- No plug-in appliances (eg. crockpots or air fryers.)
